PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Jackson called the Public Hearing to order at 6:00 pm to hear pros or cons to amend the official zoning map of Trenton, TN, to rezone the property located on Gibson Road, and described as Map: 106 I, Group A, Parcel: 007.00. There were no pros or cons and the Public Hearing closed at 6:02 pm.

Alderman Burriss led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 24, 2021 council meeting. Alderman Abbott seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Leigh Reynolds reported the expenditures for the month. Alderman Gibson made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$18,270.16 and sanitation \$48,051.50. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

CITIZENS' INPUT

Rob Blurton residing on Taylor Street, thanked the community, Mayor, Aldermen and Chief Cusson for their help with the Traveling Vietnam Wall. He presented them with a Justice for Vietnam coin.


Mayor Jackson thanked everyone that attended the 20th Anniversary Memorial Walk on September 11, 2021.


