BEER HEARING

Mayor Burriss called the Beer Hearing to order. Those present were Aldermen Graves, Wade, Harper, Alderwomen Holt, Jones, and Elam. City employees were Ricky Bailey, Phil Hickerson, Joe Wamble, Michael Estes, Terry Brown, Jeff Mccoy, Jeff Mueller, Wyatt Butler, Wilson Chute, and Leigh Reynolds. Visitors present were Carolyn Little, Peggy Thornton, Katie Huffman, Shirley Lawler, Regina Burch, Bryan Wilson, Marvin Thomas, Lillie Wade and Sam Doaks.

Quick Shop at 101 Davy Crockett Mall is applying for a beer permit. Mayor Burriss asked for any pros or cons. The beer hearing was adjourned at 6:01 pm.

REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING

Mayor Burriss stated that the agenda needed to be amended. Item #7 changing to a Farris commercial 60-inch zero turn 27 hp mower for the use at Shady Acres Park. Alderman Graves made a motion to amend the agenda. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Mayor Burriss called the regular scheduled meeting to order. Alderwoman Holt led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Leigh Reynolds stated that the sanitation budget for 2022-2023 needed to be amended. Alderman Graves made a motion to amend the 2022-2023 budget in the amount of \$69,200.00. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

CITIZENS' INPUT

Brian Wilson residing at Lombardy Street asked about a tornado shelter. The shelter could be used for tornados and a senior citizens center. Mayor Burriss stated that we had talked about applying for a tornado shelter grant but at the time the building could only be used for a shelter.

OLD BUSINESS

2ND READING-ORDINANCE #345 TO SET THE WATER RATES FOR TRENTON LIGHT AND WATER INCLUDING A 10% PRICE HIKE STARTING ON JULY 1, 2023.

Alderman Jones made a motion to pass 2nd reading on Ordinance #345 to set rates for Trenton Light and Water including a 10% price increase starting July 1, 2023. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

NEW BUSINESS

RE-APPOINT MIKE WALLSMITH TO TRENTON HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD

Alderman Jones made a motion to re-appoint Mike Wallsmith to the Trenton Housing Authority. Alderman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried with 5 yeas and 1 nay.




