Alderman Graves led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Graves made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 25, 2023 council meeting. Alderwoman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Leigh Reynolds reported the expenditures for the month. Alderwoman Jones made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$141,775.05 and sanitation \$6,837.86. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

August 22, 2023 at 10:00am will be a preconstruction meeting for bypass paving.


August 14, 2023 at 9:00am will open bids for City paving.

Site plan for TL&W is placed in the court room.


