Mayor Burriss called the regular scheduled meeting to order. Those present were Aldermen Graves, Wade, Harper, Alderwomen Holt, Jones, and Elam. City employees Ricky Bailey, Phil Hickerson, Joe Wamble, Michael Estes, Terry Brown, Bill Cusson, Jeff Mueller, Eric Horne, and Leigh Reynolds. Alderwoman Jones led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Mayor Burriss asked “to amend the agenda by adding Resolution 2023-R-18 to allow TL&W to apply for an Economic and Community Development Grant for water/wastewater system.” Alderman Graves made a motion to amend the agenda. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**ON A RECOMMENDATION FOR THE SHADY ACRES PARK BOARD, VOTE TO REFURBISH THE CONCESSION STAND RESTROOMS AT SHADY ACRES PARK WITH ARPA MONEY. THE AMOUNT USED IS NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.**

Alderwoman Elam made a motion to refurbish the concession stand restrooms at Shady Acres Park with ARPA money and not to exceed \$25,000. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. Roll Call, Aldermen Graves yes, Wade Yes Harper yes, Alderwomen Holt yes, Jones yes and Elam yes.

**RESOLUTION 2023-R-18 TO ALLOW TL&W TO APPLY FOR AN ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT FOR THE WATER/WASTEWATER SYSTEM**

Alderman Graves made a motion to pass Resolution 2023-R-18 to allow TL&W to apply for and Economic and Community Development Grant for the Water/wastewater system in the amount of \$500,000 with a 5% match. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

#### **CHIEF BILL CUSSON**

Chief Cusson stated that the Sky Cop cameras are up and fully operational. The system is for investigative purposes only. Funding for the project was awarded to the City of Trenton Police Department by the State of Tennessee's Violent Crime Grant. The cameras are flashing a blue light but in a couple of weeks we will turn them to a blue light with no flashing. The footage on the cameras will only be looked at to help solve crimes.




