Mayor Burriss called the regular scheduled meeting to order. Those present were Aldermen Wade, Harper. Alderwomen Holt, Jones, and Elam. City employees were Ricky Bailey, Phil Hickerson, Joe Wamble, Michael Estes, Terry Brown, Bill Cusson, Eric Horne, Wilson Chute, Wyatt Butler, and Leigh Reynolds. Alderwoman Holt led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2023 council meeting. Alderwoman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Leigh Reynolds reported the expenditures for the month. Alderwoman Jones made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$28,816.79 and sanitation \$10,801.60. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**RESOLUTION 2024-R-1 TO PLACE A NEW CAP ON THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATORY DAYS ALLOWED TO BE ACCUMULATED BY EMPLOYEES IN THE CITY OF TRENTON**

Alderwoman Holt made a motion to pass Resolution 2024-R-1 to place a new cap on the amount of compensatory days allowed, with a cap of 280 hours for the Fire

Department and 140 hours for the Police Department. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**RESOLUTION 2024-R-2 TO ADOPT THE CITY OF TRENTON, TENNESSEE PARKS, AND RECREATION 12 YEAR MASTER PLAN**

Alderwoman Elam made a motion to pass Resolution 2024-R-2 to adopt the City of Trenton Parks and Recreation 12-year master plan. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.



January 16, 2024 there will be a Park Board meeting at 5:00 pm.


January 22, 2024 Utility Board meeting at 8:30 am and Strategic work session after the Utility Board meeting.
