The more people that attend will give us a better chance of getting the grant.


Budget meeting April 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10:00 am.

March 29<sup>th</sup> office will be closed for Good Friday.


Holy Week is going on this week and Sunday is Easter. (Go to church)
