Alderman Wade led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Graves made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2024 council meeting. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

VOTE ON CHANGE TO PUBLIC WORKS PICK UP POLICY

Alderman Holt made a motion to change Public Works pick up policy. Alderman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Each Aldermen and Alderwomen congratulated Wyatt Butler and Justin Morris and thanked everyone for coming.


MAYOR'S REPORT
