**RESOLUTION 2025-R-1 TO BORROW \$553,000 FOR THE TENNESSEE MUNICIPAL BOND FUND AT A RATE OF 4.75% LOCKED IN FOR TWELVE-YEAR TERM TO FULFILL THE 50-50 MATCH FOR THE LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION GRANT**

Alderwoman Jones made a motion to pass Resolution 2025-R-1 to borrow \$553,000 for the Tennessee Municipal Bond fund at a rate of 4.75% locked in for twelve-year term to fulfill the 50-50 match for the local parks and recreation grant. Alderman Graves seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**RESOLUTION TO ALLOW TRENTON LIGHT AND WATER TO APPLY FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO OUR SEWER SYSTEM**

Alderman Graves made a motion to pass Resolution 2025-R-2 to allow Trenton Light and Water to apply for a CDBG grant for improvements to the sewer system. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.
