NEW BUSINESS

1ST READING OF ORDINANCE #356 ADOPTING THE CITY OF TRENTON ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026

Alderman Graves made a motion to pass 1st reading on Ordinance #356 to adopt the City of Trenton annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026 with the property tax rate \$1.28 per \$100 of assessed value.

Alderwoman Holt seconded the motion. Roll call, Aldermen Graves yes, Wade yes, Alderwomen Holt yes, Jones yes and Elam yes.
