COUNCIL MEETING

Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 22, 2025 council meeting. Alderwoman Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Leigh Reynolds reported the expenditures for the month. Alderman Graves made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$186,288.31 and sanitation \$63,224.24. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

Lillie Lancaster residing at 1016 Brookwood Street stated that a tree needs to be trimmed because it is blocking the street light and someone needs to look at her catch drain.

NEW BUSINESS

VOTE TO GRANT A BEER PERMIT FOR UE BUFFET AT 158 DAVY CROCKETT MALL

Alderwoman Jones made a motion to grant a Beer Permit to UE Buffet at 158 Davy Crockett Mall. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. Roll call, Aldermen Graves no, Wade yes, Harper yes, Alderwomen Holt yes, and Jones yes.

VOTE TO GIVE THE PROPERTY ON NORTH CHURCH STREET, PARCEL ID 094 M C 016.00 TO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY FOR A FUTURE BUILDING PROJECT

Alderman Graves made a motion to give the property on North Church Street to Habitat for Humanity for a future building project. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

VOTE TO AMEND THE 2024-2025 BUDGET TO ALLOW THE TRENTON POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE TWO NEW FORD EXPLORERS FOR \$89,092.00 TO BE PAID FOR WITH DRUG FUND MONEY. THE VEHICLES ARE TO BE USED AS PATROL CARS.

Alderman Wade made a motion to amend the 2024-2025 budget to allow the Trenton Police Department to purchase two new Ford Explorers for \$89,092.00 and to be paid with drug fund money. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. Roll call, Aldermen Graves yes, Wade yes, Harper yes, Alderwomen Holt yes, and Jones yes.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-5 TO APPROVE THE GIBSON COUNTY TRUSTEE'S OFFICE TO START COLLECTING TAXES FOR THE CITY OF TRENTON

Alderwoman Holt made a motion to pass Resolution 2025-R-5 to approve the Gibson County Trustee's office to start collecting taxes for the City of Trenton. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

Jeff Mueller stated that the court appeals did vote for cities on the lawsuit with District Attorney Agee but he can appeal with the Supreme Court.

Music on the Square will be May 17th.


