We had a meeting with MTAS today and went over the applications for Fire Chief. They will meet in the middle of October for their evaluation.


We need to resume our search for City Recorder.


Working with others on plans for a 200 Birthday for the City of Trenton. We celebrate on October 18th along with Music on the Square.
