Mayor Burriss called the regular scheduled meeting to order. Those present were Alderman Graves, Wade, Harper, Alderwomen Jones, and Elam. City employees were Ricky Bailey, Joe Wamble, Anthony Shostrand, Bill Cusson, Terry Brown, Danielle Dixon, and Leigh Reynolds.

Alderman Harper led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 25, 2025 council meeting. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Danielle Dixon reported the expenditures for the month. Alderman Graves made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$52,996.26 and sanitation \$60,136.13. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Graves made a motion to allow Danielle Dixon to sign all financial institutions and documents and remove Leigh Ann Reynolds. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-10 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR SECURITY BANK AT 211 SOUTH COLLEGE STREET FOR REPLACEMENT WINDOWS. COST OF PROJECT IS \$28,000.00 WITH A \$7,200.00 MATCH.

Alderman Harper made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-10. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-11 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR THEN AND NOW FLEA MARKET AT 204 EAST EATON STREET FOR FAÇADE IMPROVEMENTS. COST OF PROJECT IS \$3,300.00 WITH A \$825.00 MATCH.

Alderman Wade made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-11. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-12 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR SECURITY BANK AT 211 SOUTH COLLEGE STREET FOR SIGN REPLACEMENT. COST OF PROJECT IS \$4,873.00 WITH A \$1,218.25 MATCH.

Alderwoman Jones made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-12. Alderman Harper seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-13 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR FIRST STREET VISION AT 107 EAST FIRST STREET FOR SIGNAGE REPLACEMENT. COST OF PROJECT IS \$1,250.00 WITH A \$312.00 MATCH.

Alderwoman Elam made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-13. Alderman Graves seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-14 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR ROOSEVELT HALL/ MELBA'S BAKERY AND CAFÉ AT 120 SOUTH HIGH STREET FOR AWNINGS. COST OF PROJECT IS \$32,722.00 WITH AN \$8,180.50 MATCH.

Alderman Harper made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-14. Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-15 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR THE TRENTON GAZETTE AT 111 EAST FIRST STREET FOR REPLACEMENT WINDOWS. COST OF THE PROJECT IS \$40,177.00 WITH A \$10,044.25 MATCH.

Alderman Graves made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-15. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 2025-R-16 DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR STATE FARM INSURANCE AT 308 SOUTH COLLEGE STREET FOR WINDOW AND DOOR REPLACEMENT AND HANDICAP RAMP IMPROVEMENT. COST OF THE PROJECT IS \$9,704.00 WITH A \$2,426.00 MATCH.

Alderman Harper made a motion to approve resolution 2025-R-16. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.
