RECORDER'S REPORT

Alderwoman Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote. Danielle Dixon also reported the Court House has collected 30.41% of our Property Taxes for the year.

MAYOR'S REPORT



He reported that there will be a Utility Board meeting on January 26th at 10:00 am followed by a Strategic Workshop.


He reported that Danielle will be the official City Recorder after tomorrow. She will be added to all bank accounts and Leigh Ann will be removed.
