Mayor Burriss called the regular scheduled meeting to order. Those present were Alderman Graves, Wade, Alderwomen Holt, Jones, and Elam. City employees were Ricky Bailey, Phil Hickerson, Joe Wamble, Jonathan Grooms, Terry Brown, Bill Cusson, Jeff Mueller, and Danielle Dixon. Visitors present were Lillie Lancaster and Darryl Word.

Alderman Graves led the invocation with the Pledge of Allegiance to follow.

Alderman Graves made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2026 council meeting. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Danielle Dixon reported the expenditures for the month. Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the expenditures with general fund being \$42,328.40 and sanitation \$5,113.36. Alderwoman Elam seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote. Danielle also reported we received a check of \$88,905.00 from the Court House for Property Taxes.

CITIZEN'S INPUT

Darryl Word asked the council if the trash trucks will be back up and running this week. He also asked why the city did not clean side streets during this past winter storm. The mayor stated the trash trucks are back on normal schedule and stated the city does not have the equipment to clean streets.

Lillie Lancaster stated her concern about trees in her yard and hanging into the street. She does not want what happen to Nashville to happen to us, and wanted to make sure we are do everything we can to prevent this from happening. She asked why there was no salt applied on the side streets. She asked why she had to

pay a late fee for her electricity bill, if she could not get out of her house because of the snow. The mayor stated that all department heads met before the winter storm and were prepared for the winter storm. He stated thankfully the ice did not hit us like it did in Nashville, but the department heads and the city did everything they could to help with the storm with the equipment we have.

NEW BUSINESS

He reminded everyone about the events coming up which are the following:




